FEES FOR 2023

Hire Fees

Tuesday – Thursday: \$500 + GST

Friday – Saturday: \$600 + GST

Sunday: \$700 + GST

Rehearsal Fees

Tech rehearsals allow performers two hours on stage, supported by one of our technicians. Access to the venue is available for 15 minutes either side of your 2-hour booking. Any extra time on site will incur additional charges, at the rate of \$50 per 15-minute block.

Tuesday – Saturday: \$200 + GST

Sunday: \$350 + GST

Filming

If you would like footage of your performance, this can be arranged on booking for additional cost.

Unedited footage with sound synch: \$350 + GST

SHOW TIMES

Time Slots

Standard show times are 60-minutes. If you have a longer show, please speak to us before submitting your EOI.

- Tuesday to Friday shows will run at 7pm and 9pm.
- Saturday shows will run at 4pm, 6pm, 8pm, and 10pm.
- Sunday shows will run at 3pm, 5pm, and 7pm.
- Monday is a Dark Day (no shows), so we can all rest and recover ready for another week!

Bump In and Out

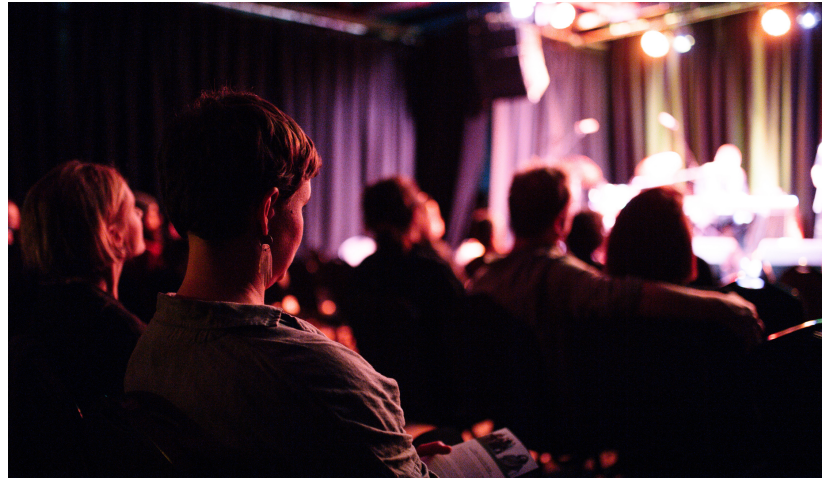
Fringe is a busy time, with back-to-back shows meaning both stage and dressing room access is limited. Artists have dressing room access 30 minutes prior to your performance time and stage access for 15 minutes during this time for any presets.

After your performance, the stage must be cleared within 10 minutes of the show's scheduled end time, and the dressing room cleared within 30 minutes. Please see an example schedule below:

- 6.30pm: Dressing room access
- 6.30-6.45pm: Stage access (stage cleared at 6.40pm)
- Showtime: 7-8pm
- 8.10pm: Stage cleared
- 8.30pm: Dressing room cleared

Any extra time on site will incur additional charges, at the rate of \$50 per 15-minute block.

Liquor Licence Capacity: 200

Maximum ticket sales per event: 180

Please note that the 200 capacity includes everyone in the venue during an event (artists, staff, technicians, and complimentary ticket holders).

Front of House

Nexus Arts will provide Front of House staff for ticket and merchandise sales. Cash door takings will be recorded and handed to you at the end of each show. The Venue Manager, Artist and Front of House staff must sign off on the documentation at the end of each show. EFTPOS sales will be recorded, and money will be remitted to you within 14 days, minus the bank fees (2.5%), if there are no outstanding invoices.

Marketing

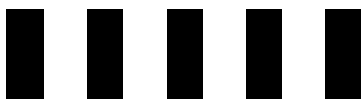

Piano

Nexus Arts Venue has a baby grand piano that artists are welcome to use for performances in our 2023 Adelaide Fringe program. In 2023 we will cover tuning fees for the piano. Please mention if you would like to use the piano in your EOI.

Potential Hazards

Nexus Arts takes the safety of our performers, staff and audience extremely seriously. Our contract terms and conditions specify our requirements and indicate the ramifications for damage, breach of safety conditions and emergency services call outs. If your performance includes anything potentially hazardous or messy, please clearly detail this in your EOI.

Cancellations made by the artist/presenter after 20 October will forfeit any deposit payments made to Nexus Arts.

Cancellations by the artist/presenter made within 30 days of the event will require full payment of any hire fees.
